I was born on February, 10, 1976.

I have graduated from Moscow State University. I got a PhD degree in mathematics in 2002. Now I am teaching students.

I live in a small town Ivanteevka approx. 10 km far from Moscow. I am married with one son.

I began playing correspondence chess at age 14 when my coach, correspondence chess International Master, EU ex-champion Mikhail Govbinder, persuaded me to try it. I did and liked play via postal mail. I have been playing cc for 26 years and still enjoy it!

In 2009 I was elected as a member of Russian Correspondence Chess Association board. In 2011 I became a vice-president and in 2015 was elected as the President of RCCA.

In 2010 I started my TD and TO career in ICCF. I am a Tournament Organiser of more than 200 both domestic and international tournaments. The most successful are three multi-staged events: International Memorial Alpert Cup (2010-2017, 364 entries); RCCA 20 Years International Open (in progress, 455 entries); ICCF World Cup 20 (in progress, 1001 entries – the largest number of entries for server World Cups). I have also organized the 5th edition of Slav Cup Team Tournament and helped Sergey Grodzenskiy with the organization of the European Team Championship (10th Final, 11th Semifinals) this year. With the help of my friends I organized four matches Russia vs ICCF Zones: v Zone 1 (Europe, 100 boards) in 2012, Zone 4 (Africa/Asia, 66 boards) in 2016, Zone 2 (Latin America, 182 boards) in 2017 and Zone 3 (North America/Pacific, 136 boards) in 2017.

I received International Arbiter Title in 2014.

I am a member of the Disciplinary Committee (since 2012) and Rules Commission (since 2016).

Taking in consideration that this election is being held in the middle of the 4-years-term, if elected as Zonal Director, my main purpose will be to save a team of European Organisers harmless and to support their invaluable work. I am both young (41) for correspondence chess and experienced as TO and TD. I am open to innovations and have some ideas of new events which might be attractive for players of different levels.
