

Regulations

International School Friendly Event

1. Purpose:

To integrate school children within common passion chess.

2. Tournament Organizer

The Polish Correspondence Chess Commission of the Polish Chess Federation is organising this tournament.

3. Period of play

The tournament is supposed to start on 2018-10-15 with end date 2019-05-31.

4. Participation and entries

This is an invitational event. Invited school teams are eligible to participate in this event free of charge. The organizer reserves the right to reject entry without giving a reason.

There will be 4 server boards (1xgame/board) - 4 players in each team (1xteacher, 3xstudents). A maximum of 2 players may be replaced during the tournament, no more than one per board.

All entries should include following details: player's name & ICCF ID, board order, Team Captain's name & ICCF ID.

Entries containing player's name, date of birth, e-mail address, living place, ICCF ID and current rating should be forwarded by e-mail to Mariusz Wojnar, e-mail: mariusz.wojnar@gmail.com, to reach him before 30th September 2018.

5. Playing system

This team tournament is unrated and it is supposed to be a single round robin event played by ICCF server.

6. Time control and rules

Standard [ICCF Rules](#) apply. They are available at the ICCF website under ICCF Rules tab.

The event will be unrated. Time control - an incremental rate of play (initial time: 20 days per game plus increment: 1 move in 3 days with duplication after 20 days; 10 days leave per calendar year, no special leave). It's possible that Triple block system will be used. It will be decided later and placed in separate starting message.

Linear conditionals can be entered. This tournament allows claims based on the 6-piece tablebase. No 50-move rule when a 7-piece ending is present.
