According to the tournament regulations "the total prize fund for this event is 1 000 EUR. Cash prizes of 600 EUR, 300 EUR and 100 EUR will be awarded to the top 3 players provided they obtain a positive result (>50%). Tie-breaks will not be applied in respect of these cash prizes and instead those players scoring equal points will equally share any prize money due."

In view of the above, the following players will receive cash prizes in the amount of:

- 450 EUR Evgeny Filin
- 450 EUR Jan Židů

Gordon M. Anderson, the Finance Director, will arrange the payment.

The following special qualification provisions have been achieved in the 70th ICCF Jubilee Chess 960 World Elite event (required result above 50%):

- Evgeny Filin qualified for a World Championship final;
- Jan Židů qualified for a World Championship Candidates (upon payment of the entry fee).
